Our clients are encouraged to have a companion go with them if that will help make the trip more comfortable, at no charge.

The trips may be for scans, doctor visits, treatments, picking up medications, so long as it is directly related to cancer. The trips are at no charge to the client.

We are in need of drivers in both the county of Athabasca and the County of Lac La Biche. If you or someone you know is interested please get in touch with our Coordinator Jessica today.

Our drivers are able to claim mileage at rates set out annually by the CRA which is currently \$0.70 per km for the first 5,000 km. They can also submit a meal expense for themselves and the client.
